# **Lexical Lab Summer School**

## **Advanced Language and Culture**

Our Lexical Lab summer courses take place at London Metropolitan University, Holloway Road campus. It's a two-minute walk from Holloway Road tube station, which is on the Piccadilly Line. From here, you can get to Holborn in central London in eight minutes. The venue is also a ten-minute walk from Highbury and Islington station, which is on the Victoria line and has a range of overground services. We suggest you check <a href="https://citymapper.com/london">https://citymapper.com/london</a> for journey times and routes.

## **Registration fee**

The course fee includes an £80 registration fee that covers admin, materials, entrance to timetabled visits, but *not* transport.

### Accommodation

In general, we recommend attendees sort out their own accommodation, but we are happy to advise and help out. We may, though, be able to offer some basic single rooms in a student residence two minutes from Wood Green underground station (Zone 3), which is a ten-minute tube ride from our training venue. If we are able to block-book this, you'd have an individual bedroom, but share a bathroom and kitchen. You'd usually share these with other participants on the course. The cost is around **£200 / week** plus a **£40 booking fee**.

We will wait to see how many people are interested in this option before booking. If you want to be considered for this, please let us know ASAP so by the end of the year, we can make an informed decision on whether or not to block-book rooms.

Peak travel to our venue **£2.50**. Oyster card / Contactless payment for zones 1-3 costs is a maximum **£45.20 / week**.

If this does not suit your needs, you can try <u>London Homestays</u> or <u>Londonist</u>, which are both British Council accredited. In the past, we have found they had very limited availability for one and two-week stays and generally offered student residences. Otherwise, you may try websites such as <u>Homestay.com</u>, <u>AirBnbB</u> and <u>Student.com</u>. Prices will vary from around  $\pm 200 - \pm 450$ /week including fees.

## **Course Outline**

This course is aimed at anyone with a level of English between B2 and C2. It will give you confidence and familiarity with current issues, media representations, stereotypes, cultural and political figures and recent events in Britain. The focus is largely on modern culture, although there is also some historical content too. Material and tasks are more adult and appropriate for university-level students or simply for your own pleasure and language learning! The course combines discussions, lectures, different media and visits within London on the connected themes

## Content

Course content is divided by week. We offer a choice of topics each week to provide some flexibility, and we will provide a questionnaire for participants before you arrive so you can express preferences or make requests, which we will try to incorporate into the course where there is agreement between participants.

Common UK cultural stereotypes Regions and cities Brexit: nostalgia and myths Windrush and immigration The law and crime Sport and society Royal family and influence Education Class Family

#### Week 2

Women in UK society Comedy and Stand-up UK Media and Music Housing and regeneration Family Literature Health and the Health service Drinking and drug culture Youth issues Food – people and influences

After this course, participants will:

- be more comfortable in their knowledge of contemporary UK culture
- be better able to deal with cultural references in conversation
- be more able to understand colloquial language
- be aware of a variety of internet resources and writers for study beyond the course
- go away with some material they can use in adult or university classes
- know London better
